- 2. Proposed Amendment to Lease Document – Section 3: Permitted Uses (20 mins)**

Purpose of Item: Vote Request

A revision to the existing lease agreement has been proposed, specifically in Section 3: Permitted Uses. The proposed addition states:

"Incidental storage of non-aeronautical items as defined by FAA regulation is also permitted."

The Airport Authority requests that the Board of Directors review this proposed amendment and determine its approval through a formal vote. This decision will help clarify permitted uses within leased facilities and maintain consistency with FAA standards.

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(Lease Amendment cont.)

SECTION 3. PERMITTED USES – Hangar use shall be limited to the following aeronautical uses: 1. Storage of Aircraft; 2. Final assembly of aircraft under construction; 3. Non-commercial construction of amateur-built or kit-built aircraft; 4. Maintenance, repair, or refurbishment of aircraft, but not the indefinite storage of nonoperational aircraft; 5. Storage of aircraft handling equipment, e.g. towbars, glider tow equipment, workbenches, and tools and materials used in the servicing, maintenance, repair or outfitting of aircraft: **Incidental storage of non-aeronautical items as defined by the FAA regulations is also permitted.** No other use is permitted. No commercial aviation activity shall be conducted utilizing Premises. Tenant shall promptly provide Landlord with a copy of the title or lease demonstrating Tenant’s ownership or rights as a Lessee of the aircraft stored at the Premises at the time the aircraft is located on the Premises.

4. Casa Cola Roadway Extension and Taxiway F Extension (Final Design, Permitting, and Bidding)

Purpose of Item: Information for Future Vote (20 Mins)

The Casa Cola Roadway Extension and Taxiway F Extension projects are advancing toward their final stages of development. These critical infrastructure improvements were previously discussed at a Board meeting in late 2024, during which direction was sought regarding layout options for Casa Cola Way. As the projects move forward, it is essential to finalize the design, permitting, and bidding process to ensure timely and efficient execution in 2025.

To facilitate informed decision-making, Passero will reengage with the Board to provide updates and address any outstanding considerations. As part of this effort, Passero will deliver a detailed presentation outlining the proposed plans, project scope, and key milestones. This presentation will offer an opportunity for discussion and feedback to refine the project approach and ensure alignment with strategic objectives.

The final design, permitting, and bidding phases are crucial steps in advancing these projects to completion. Continued collaboration and engagement will be essential in ensuring that the Casa Cola Roadway Extension and Taxiway F Extension meet operational needs and long-term development goals.
